• Authors information:

- The authors should submit extended abstracts up to 2 pages (maximum 8000 symbols). The abstract should contain: 1) paper title, 2) five keywords in order of importance, 3) authors' names and full addresses, 4) name, address, phone, fax and e-mail of the author to whom subsequent correspondence should be directed. The abstract should state clearly the background, objectives, results and conclusions. It may content figures, tables and pictures.
- The Organizing Committee will inform you for acceptance of your paper for oral or poster presentation.

• Young Authors' Competition for Best Presentation:

- The young authors who would like to take part in Competition for Best Presentation (first author under 35) must indicate this in Participation Form.
- The papers for the competition will be reviewed and evaluated by special Competition Commission. Six of the presented papers will be selected for oral presentation on the conference. The best three presentations elected by both, the participants and Competition Commission will be awarded. The rest papers could participate in the competition for best poster award.
- The evaluation criteria for the competition are: correspondence with the conference title, actuality, clear statement of objectives, subject, results and conclusions, understandability, attractiveness and visualization, balance between text and images.
- Working language: English and Bulgarian
