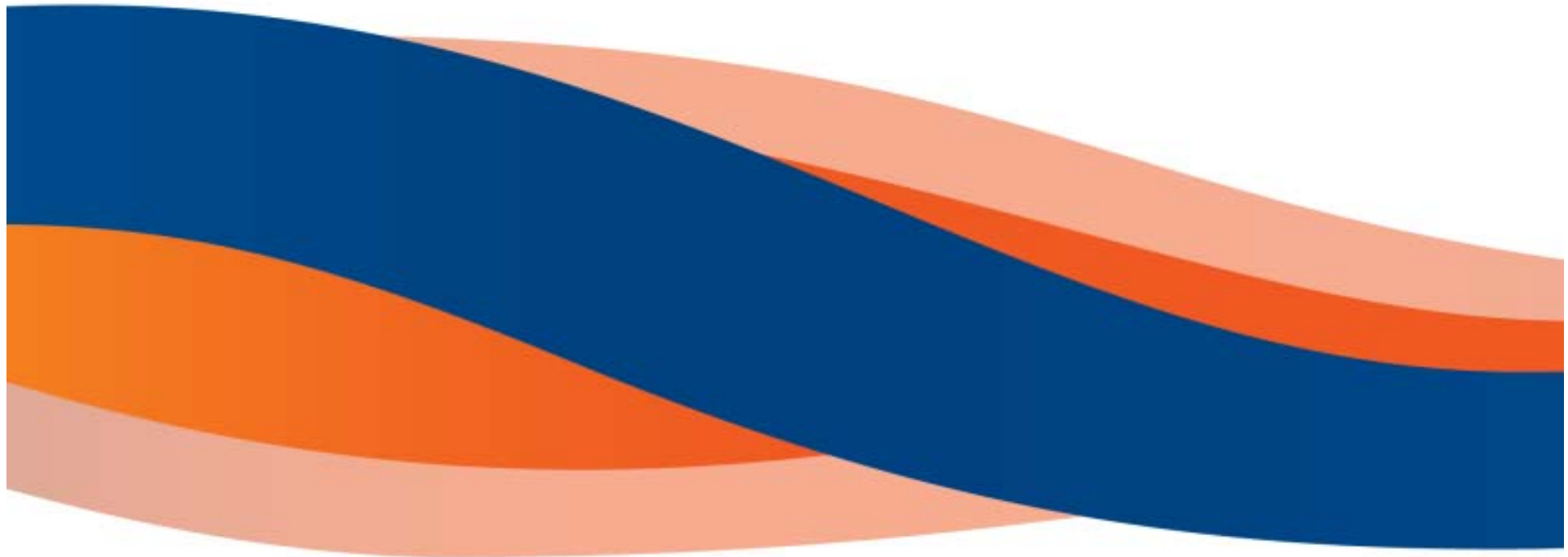

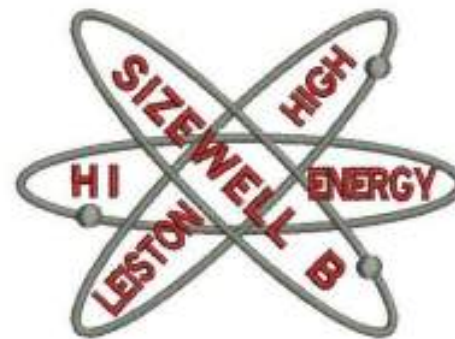


The submission – Hi-Energy Partnership

Hi-Energy Partnership

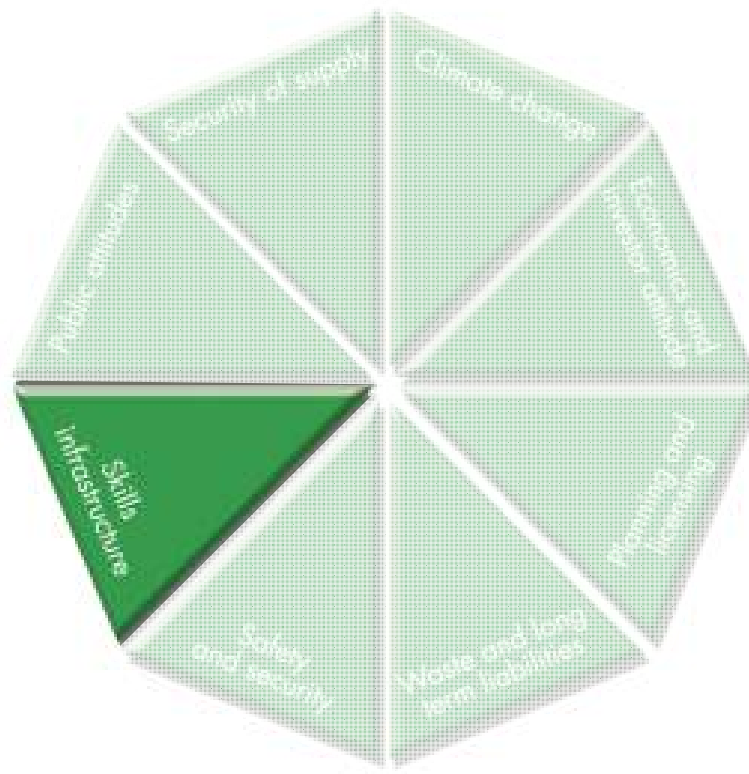
- > to promote **British Energy** and **Sizewell B**:
